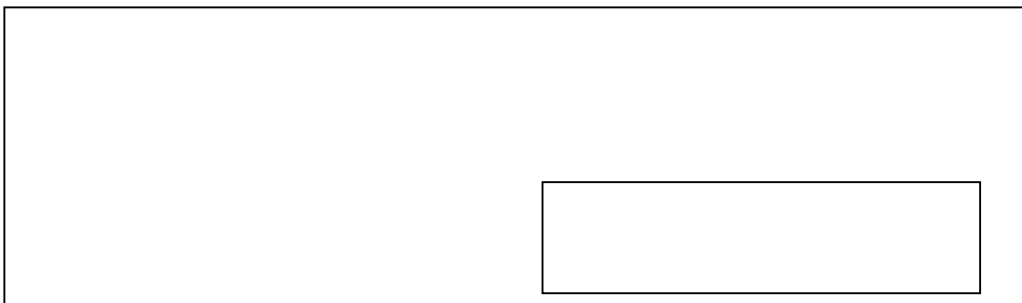

SAFEGUARDING IN THE DIOCESE OF BIRMINGHAM SCIE REVIEW

Archbishop Bernard Longley has commissioned a review of our current Safeguarding/ child protection practices in light of the national Catholic policies and Procedures. This review is to be welcomed as a means of ensuring that our systems to protect our children and young people are as effective as possible. This review is being conducted by an independent charity called SCIE (Social Care Institute for Excellence). As part of the review, SCIE would like to speak with any individuals who have had an experience with any safeguarding issues within the Archdiocese and have experience of working with our parish safeguarding representatives and the safeguarding team at the Archdiocese. DATA PROTECTION REGARDING THE SICK LIST.

If your name or the name of a friend or relative of yours is on the parish list of prayers for those who are sick, and you would like that name to remain on the list, would you please contact Fr Pat or the office.

We need to make sure that you or your friend or family member has consented to their name being on that list. This is because the list can be seen by a lot of people, as it is put up on the notice board outside the church and is available for anyone to pick up in church. It is NOT published on the internet through the parish website.

In a couple of weeks' time the list will be restarted with the names of all for whom the parish have consent. This is necessary to make sure the church takes proper care of your information and complies with current data protection law. **PLEASE NOTE THE SICK LIST WILL BE UPDATED ON MONDAY 3RD SEPTEMBER 2018 TO INCLUDE ONLY THOSE WHO HAVE PROVIDED THE PERMISSION SLIPS.**
