GOSPEL REFLECTION

Jesus, in today's Gospel, says that His disciples belong to the world no more than He belongs to the world. Yet, He also says that He is not removing them from the world. In fact, He will be sending them into the world to proclaim His Word. It is by following his teachings and by giving witness to them that should give meaning to their lives. These teachings are based on loving one another, compassion and forgiveness. The values of the world, greed, power and the need to be popular must not be the motivating force in our lives. Yet, the need to be accepted by the world can all too easily be stronger than loyalty to Christ. However, with the guidance of the Holy Spirit we can show that true joy and peace can come only from being ourselves.
