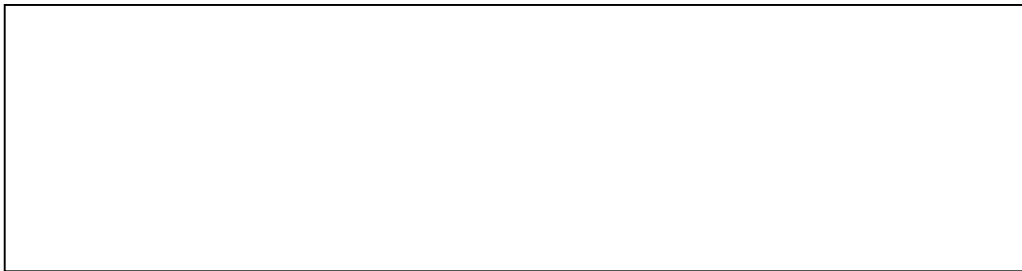

REFLECTION

Today is Pentecost when the Lord gives the Holy Spirit to the Church. The Holy Spirit is often called the Paraclete which means 'to call alongside'. It has called alongside the Apostles and their successors, our bishops, as teachers to lead and guide the church as witnesses to the love and truth of Christ in the world. However, it is who called alongside us to guide us as we try to follow the Lord in our lives. The Holy Spirit enables us to walk in the light. When we experience darkness in our lives it is the Holy Spirit that lights up the way forward and reminds us of God's love in our hearts. Sometimes it is easier to stay in the darkness than to accept the light. We must be careful not to let this happen. Let us pray that we may always let the Holy Spirit, the Paraclete, illuminate our lives and be our consolation when we find things hard.
