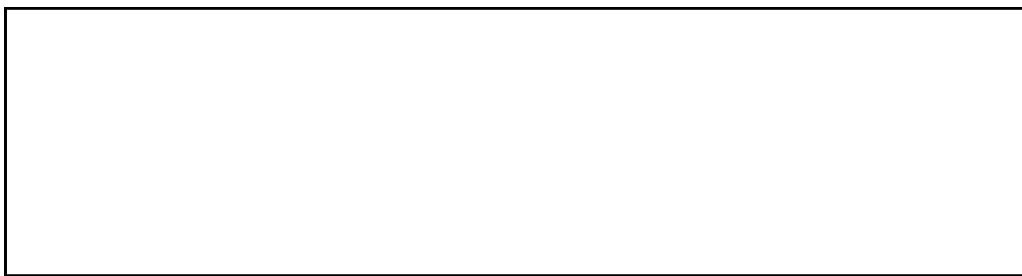

FOOD BANK REFERRALS TRIPLE SINCE IN SIX MONTHS

Referrals to the food bank have continued to rise and have tripled since September last year. Presently the shortages we have are: Tinned fruit, custard and rice pudding; tinned meat products, tinned pasta in sauce eg ravioli and spaghetti hoops, pasta sauces, tinned vegetables and pulses eg carrots, peas, kidney beans, chick peas, as well as toilet rolls and deodorants.

We continue to have ample supplies of pasta, baked beans, soup and tinned tuna. Your support for the food bank is much needed and appreciated.
