always be generous in your response to his appeal.

THE PAPAL VISIT

Information has now come through from the Diocesan Coordinator of the Papal Visit. regarding the arrangements for the Beatification Mass at Lofton Park, Longbridge, Birmingham on Sunday 19 September, with action that we must take. First of all, it has been decided that all those attending the Papal events are to be referred to as 'Pilgrims' rather than 'guests' or 'ticket holders'. Parishes have been issued with an allocation of places, based on Sunday Mass attendance. If you have booked a place on the list for the Beatification Mass please confirm your booking as soon as possible. We will have to give in the numbers in a couple of weeks. The cost for each person, including children, is £25 which will include the transport and a Pilgrim Pack. The Parish will subsidise the children. There are still some places left so it is not too late to book. Children will have to be accompanied by an adult. We have booked 10 coaches for the Deanery. There are three pick-up points for the coaches: Woodford Way Car Park Witney, Water Eaton Park and Ride North Oxford, and St Gregory the Great School Cowley Oxford. There will be a Pilgrim Leader appointed to each coach who will have a list of names of Pilgrims on his/her coach. Each pilgrim will be issued with a wrist band. We will keep you informed as the information comes in. Please continue to pray that the Pope's visit will be fruitful and bring many blessings to the Diocese and the country.

Latest E mail from the Diocesan Coordinator: REQUIRED: Urgent security information of all Pilgrims attending the Beatification Mass i.e. Title, Name, Address including post code, best contact number, mobile and e mail. It is essential that this information is sent in to Archbishops Secretary as soon as possible and no later than **4 August** for submission to the Bishop's Conference. Detailed slips are on the table in the church porch, please fill one in and place in basket marked "Completed Pilgrim Slips" (one for each pilgrim - including children.) They have to be completed and forwarded next week. Apologies for this extra work necessitated by security requirements.
