CHANGES IN THE COMING TAX YEAR

From **April 6th 2012** the amount of tax rebate charities may reclaim from Gift Aid Contributions is to be lowered from 28p to 25p in £1. We appeal to Tax Paying parishioners, who have not already done so, to consider creating a Gift Aid in favour of the parish. If this is done now it will give time for the paperwork to be completed before the new tax year begins. Forms may be found in the Church Porch, from Fr Pat or from David Bolley. We need to be informed of any changes of circumstances of parishioners who already Gift Aid e.g. changes of address etc.

Our thanks go to those already using the system either through Weekly Offertory Envelopes or Banking Standing Order Mandates—the latter are particularly helpful since cash does not have to be carried to the Bank which has safety implications for us.
