GOSPEL REFLECTION

The people who remarked about the temple would have been impressed about how strong it seemed. Yet, as Jesus says, one day it will be completely flattened. Likewise, people feel strong and secure when everything is going right in their lives. Yet, like the

temple, when things start going bad they may feel their lives are falling apart. However, the Lord tells his followers to expect to have real difficulties in their lives, possibly even ridicule or persecution. Still, he says, "Not a hair of your head will perish". It is from within, from the presence of Jesus in our hearts that gives true strength and security, not what happens externally. So, this temple appeared strong and secure yet was to be destroyed by the Romans in AD 70. 




YOUTH GROUP NEWS

At our recent Youth Group session on 9th November, we reflected on the significance of November as a month of




