DEDICATION OF THE LATERAN BASILICA



The Lateran Basilica is the oldest and most important basilica in Rome. serving as the official cathedral of the Pope and the Archdiocese of Rome. Its dedication marks a significant event in Christian history, as it was built on land donated to the Church by Emperor Constantine after the Edict of Milan in 313 AD, which granted religious freedom to Christians.

The Basilica was constructed over the ancient Lateran Palace, and upon its completion, it was dedicated by Pope Sylvester I to Christ the Saviour. on November 9, 324.
