GOSPEL REFLECTION

Reading today's gospel reminds me of what seems to be happening more and more today. That is, people not accepting responsibility for their actions. They either claim to have done nothing wrong when it is clear they have or say that it is not their fault. Jesus is reminding us that the motivations that direct our actions and behaviour

towards other people start in the heart. We may even act in our relations to other people following Christian principles but our hearts may be far from the Lord. The law of Moses describes how we should relate to each other. Jesus is updating the Law by saying that it is giving our hearts over to the Lord that counts. That way how can we hate our enemies and have lust in our hearts? God Bless. Fr Pat
