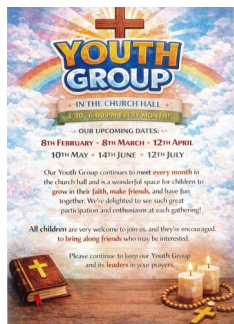

Next year's Pilgrimage to Lourdes is 25th-30th May 2026. Going to Lourdes with the Diocese is by far the best way to experience it!



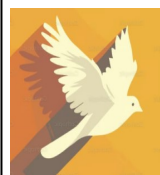
