GOSPEL REFLECTION

In today's Gospel we hear the terrifying line "Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul; fear him rather who can destroy both body and soul in hell." This is a warning against complacency. Yes, God loves us but, He is still God, the All-Powerful Creator of the Universe. We must not take Him for granted. We are accountable to Him as God. We must never forget that. We must not allow ourselves to become comfortable and simply presume on God's love. However, He does not wish our relationship with Him to be one of fear. Jesus goes on to say in the Gospel do not be afraid, after all, every hair on your head has been counted. God has called us into a loving relationship with Him through His Son Jesus Christ. We have nothing to fear if we truly love Him and try to follow Him. To deny God's authority it is to deny who He is. We are challenging His integrity. He created us so, if we deny His integrity, we deny our own. God will not punish us; we will simply not be capable of accepting His love. GARDEN PARTY AT NEWMAN'S COLLEGE

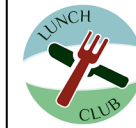
